



## A new listening experience

Here's a quick guide to getting started with your Easi-Ears. For more detailed instruction see the User Guide.

- 1) Your Easi-Ears headphones and the remote control unit will have some charge in them when taken straight out of the box. However, it's best to give them a full charge before use. Simply ensure that all the headphones and the remote control unit are properly docked, plug in the docking station and leave for approx 16 hours to fully charge the set. More on p.4 of the user guide.



- 2) Whilst your headphones are charging you can install the software. The software is installed by inserting the CD into the disk drive. You will need to do this for each machine you wish to use the software on. The installation should start automatically. More on p.10 of the user guide.



- 3) The Easi-Ears headphones, remote control unit and software all come pre-loaded with a sample audio track so you have some content to listen to right away. This is an audio book title, 'The New Playground' from the Kids & Co series by publisher Rising Stars.

To add an audio track to the headphones/remote control unit or to remove a track, you will need to dock the headphones and remote control unit in the docking station and connect the docking station to your PC. The docking station will need to be powered. The Easi-Ears software then enables you to browse to the file desired on your PC, or to select the track you wish to remove and delete it. More on p.14 of the user guide.



- 4) The new audio tracks you select get placed in 'My Library' and from here you can create your own playlists. Playlists can be copied to all headphones and the remote control unit, or just those selected. It's also easy to simply drag individual audio files onto your chosen devices. More on p.11 of the user guide.
